Northwestern Coaches

Brian Wede

Head Coach

The 2019 season will mark Wede's 14th as the head coach, after serving as an assistant coach for two seasons. Wede's teams have won 346 games and seven conference championships. Northwestern has also been very strong in the post season winning 38 postseason games, best in the GPAC. Wede, the winningest coach in the history of the program, has been named the GPAC Coach of the Year following the 2013 and 2018 seasons.

Coach Wede has had the privilege of coaching eight NAIA All-Americans and 96 all conference players in his time as head coach. This has included two GPAC pitchers of the year and two GPAC players of the year. He has also had 34 NAIA Scholar Athletes during his career.

Wede and his wife Nicole have one son, Nikolai, and two daughters, Larkin and Shea.

Jared Kirkeby

Head Assistant Coach / Pitching Coach

Coach Kirkeby is in his fourth season as an assistant coach for Northwestern. He is a full time employee at Northwestern and also works as an assistant sports information director on campus.

Kirkeby, a 2012 graduate of Northwestern, returns to his Alma mater after teaching/coaching in the Cherokee Community School District.

Kirkeby enjoyed a stellar career as a left handed pitcher at Northwestern winning 18 games (ninth best in school history) and throwing 182 innings (18th most all time). Kirkeby made 28 starts and 26 relief appearances in his career throwing eight complete games and two shutouts. His sophomore campaign saw him go 7-4 in 65 innings. His best ERA campaign came as a senior when he posted a 2.79 ERA in 51.2 innings, going 4-3. For his career Kirkeby walked 63 batters in 183 innings.

Northwestern went 112-85 during Kirkeby's four seasons including a GPAC Tournament championship in 2010 and a GPAC regular season championship in 2011.

Kirkeby and his wife Heather have two daughters, Jocelyn and Elyse.

Robby Laughlin

Assistant Coach

Coach Laughlin is in his third year on coaching staff. Laughlin lettered on Varsity 2014-17. In 2018 Laughlin became a student assistant and completed his degree from Northwestern. Laughlin has taken a roll on campus as an admissions counselor and assistant baseball coach, while working toward his Master's degree.

Laughlin works with the hitters and catchers and was an integral part of leading the 2018 Raiders to regular season and tournament GPAC Championships.

Grades 3-7

Players will receive quality instruction on the basic fundamentals of hitting from the camp staff. The main focus will be on grip, stance, proper load, balance and weight transfer throughout the swing. Stations will be set up to re-enforce these fundamentals. Players will participate in a hitting talk, stations, and competitive games.

Grades 8-12

Players will receive quality instruction on the fundamentals of hitting from the coaching staff and players. The focus will be on stance, proper load, weight transfer, swing path, overall swing mechanics, as well as approach and the mental side of hitting. Stations will be set up to reinforce these fundamentals. Players will participate in a comprehensive hitting talk, stations, and competitive games.
